What is your name?

When/where were you born?

What do you do for a living (e.g., farmer, writer, store clerk)?

If you are married, what is your spouses name?

When/where was he/she born?

What does he/she do for a living?

If you have children, what are their names, and when/where were they born?

If you live in the Village of Donalda, are you the first family to live in your house? If not, who was there before you? Do you know when it was built, and by whom?

Did you go to school in town, or to a country school (and which one)?

If you don't live in the village, where do you live now? (School district name, land location, or name of other town.)

When did your family come to Donalda? How long did they stay? Where did they go when they left?

Did your family own a business in Donalda—or work in one? Which one, and when?

Do any of your children have families of their own? If so, what are the names of their spouses and children?

Do you have any special memories or family stories about your family's time in Donalda?
